Additional personal life-saving appliances

3.26 (1) A fishing vessel shall carry on board the following additional personal life-saving appliances:

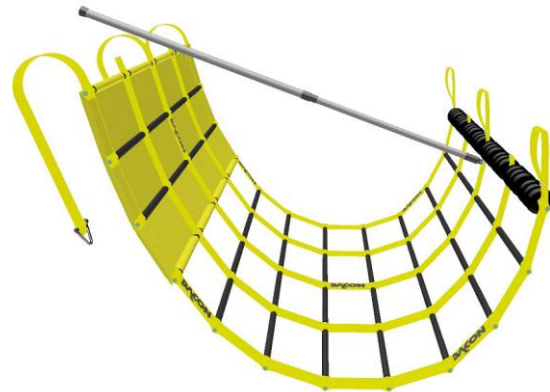
- (a) a reboarding device;
- (b) an apparatus that can be used to retrieve a person who has fallen overboard **without the assistance of the person overboard**, unless the vessel carries a recovery boat or the operator of the vessel is the only person on board;
