Call 604-276-3100 (1-888-621-7233 toll free) to speak with a prevention officer about your master/employer's duty to take reasonable steps to prevent workplace bullying and harassment.
 If the issue has not been resolved after reporting the incident to your master/employer and discussing it with a prevention officer, you may submit a complaint to WorkSafeBC. WorkSafeBC may make further inquiries into the steps the master/employer has taken to prevent workplace bullying and harassment.
